Notes

1. This form may be completed by one of the partners on behalf of both.
2. At least seven days' notice is required before the first reading of the banns.
3. If either of you will not be 18 by the proposed date of the wedding, the clergy will need to know whether the consent of parents or guardians has been obtained.
4. The question "which is your parish church?" means the Church of England parish in which you live. If either of you lives in a different parish from that in which the marriage is to take place, you have to arrange for the banns to be read there as well, and obtain a banns certificate.
5. If you do not live in the parish of All Saints' and are not on the electoral roll, it may still be possible to be married here by using a qualifying connection to this parish. Details of qualifying connections are as follows:-

You can marry in a Church of England church if you can show:

That one of you:

- has at any time lived in the parish for a period of at least 6 months or
- was baptised in the parish concerned or
- was prepared for confirmation in the parish or
- has at any time regularly attended the parish church for a period of at least 6 months

or

That one of your parents, at any time after you were born:

- has lived in the parish for a period of at least 6 months or
- has regularly gone to normal services in the parish church for a period of at least 6 months

or

That one of your parents or grandparents:

- was married in the parish church
